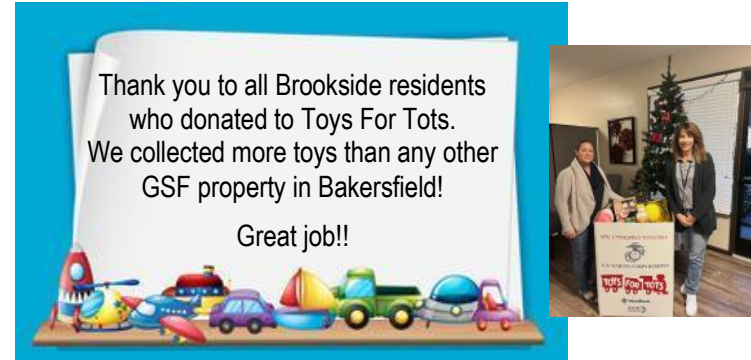

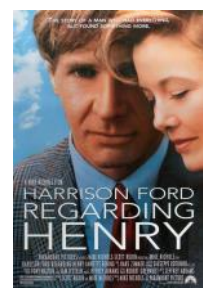
January 10th at 2:30pm Two Weeks Notice 2002 1hr 41min

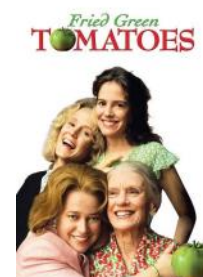
January 17th at 2:30pm Midnight in Paris 2011 1hr 34min

Regarding Animals/Pets/Pest

- ◆ Dogs are not allowed to be walked through the Clubhouse.
- ◆ Clean up after your pets. Pet waste is unsanitary.
- ◆ Pets MUST be on a leash while walking the property.
- ◆ Do NOT feed the stray/wild animals: cats, kit foxes, squirrels, etc.
- ◆ The chemicals used by Pest Control will counteract with store bought products like, Raid, Hot Shot, etc. Try spraying bugs with household cleaners, like Windex, to kill them in between Pest Control service days.

Regarding Maintenance

- ◆ Submit a maintenance request when the ac filter needs to be replaced.
- ◆ Avoid putting food down the garbage disposal. Especially, peelings, pasta, rice, etc. These items will jam the disposal.
- ◆ Try plunging toilet before submitted a maintenance request for a clogged toilet.
- ◆ Clearing a clogged drain is a tenant charge if it is due to a blockage caused by the tenant. Examples: hair, too much toilet paper, wipes, items, food, etc.
- ◆ Always call the Office at (661) 833-8833 for Maintenance Emergencies. This is the ONLY way of contacting the Emergency Operator after hours.

Regarding Responsibilities

- ◆ Resident parking is not assigned and is first come first serve. All guests, family, friends, and caretakers must park in the UN-COVERED areas.
- ◆ All vehicles must be properly parked within the parking space and are not crossing over into the next parking space.
- ◆ Use caution while driving in the complex. Remind guests to drive slow through the property.
- ◆ No parking along red curbs.
- ◆ No planting in flower beds. Only two (2) personal items allowed in flower beds.
